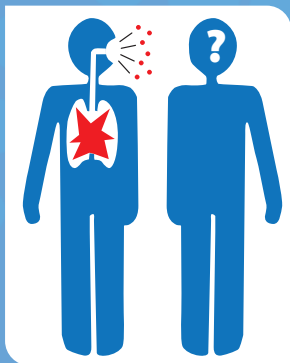


Why should I have a chest X-ray?



To see if you have tuberculosis (TB), a disease transmitted through the air, which mainly affects the lungs and which can be serious:

- you come from a country where this illness is more common than in France,
- you have been in contact with someone suffering from tuberculosis (TB),
- you have symptoms of the disease: severe fatigue, losing weight, fever, night sweats, you have a cough, or you've coughed up blood.

You may be suffering from this illness without feeling the telltale signs: the chest X-ray allows us to see whether your lungs are affected by the illness.

Practicalities :

People must come with proof of their identity to create a medical file.

If the chest X-ray is abnormal the Centre for the Fight against Tuberculosis (CLAT) will be informed and a follow-up appointment will be organised.
